

Letter from Uplift Northwest Executive Director

Dear Friends:

Thank you for participating in this year's Celebrity Waiter's Luncheon. We are sincerely thankful for another year of partnering with Celebrity Waiters as we celebrate our Centennial Year in 2021! We have been changing lives for 100 years.

For those whom I have not had the opportunity to meet yet, my name is Gina Hall, and I joined Uplift Northwest in November 2020. I have served the non-profit sector for over 20 years leading organizations whose missions include the development of affordable housing and supportive services, the management of creek restoration, job training and education programs, youth program development, and support to individuals in our community who have been underserved and disenfranchised for a variety of reasons. It is hard to believe 2020 is over and so much has changed in our lives. Although there were insurmountable challenges for many families last year, we have emerged hopeful for a bright future ahead.

Everywhere we look, there is work to be done and Uplift Northwest is well-positioned to do this work. The state of the economy calls for action, and Uplift Northwest will act. Not only will we identify where new jobs will emerge while strengthening those that remain, but we will also team up with our employer partners to co-create entry-level and living-wage jobs for our workers. We will build alliances with both public and private sector partners. We will build an inclusive model of employment service delivery that brings diverse experiences, perspectives, and voices into the conversation. I am committed to creating a culture of inclusivity and belonging at Uplift Northwest. My vision is that our collective, including those who support and partner with us in our work, will be reflective of the diversity that exists in the broader community.

I am amazed with how Uplift Northwest, in recent years, transitioned from a day-labor model to a fully-functioning temporary staffing agency. Just like our founder Martin Johanson did in 1921, we continue to provide meals, clothing, and equipment to people in need. We continue to emphasize the power of what work does for an individuals as we manage an ever-growing network of local employers.

Your support of our unique social enterprise that provides employment training and supportive services gives men and women the tools to get on the path to a livable wage. By investing your dollars, hiring our workers, and volunteering your time, you are providing a practical, realistic solution that encourages personal growth, accountability, and responsibility. Together, we can overcome this current economic crisis and create a healthier future for Seattle and this region.

Since 1921, Uplift Northwest (previously known as Millionair Club Charity) has connected men and women with the vital resources they need to become job ready. Through our unique temporary staffing agency and supportive employment program, workers gain access to local employers, free meals, free prescription glasses, free laundry and shower services, and a wide-reaching referral network to best help them on their paths to stability.

After seven years of being the CWL beneficiary, we are grateful to all of the waiters and their guests for your generous support of over \$1,000,000!

You have supported:

- A new shower and laundry center providing 10,000 showers and loads of laundry annually
- Kitchen updates that support food production for 100,000 meals per year
- In 2020, workers earned \$1.67 million in wages and achieved 90,215 hours of work
- In 2020, 61 men and women earned full-time jobs
- In 2020, 210 workers received housing assistance thanks to their working status

2021 Community Service Award

Jack Sikma

Jack Sikma arrived in Seattle after being drafted by the Seattle Supersonics in the summer of 1977.

His basketball career hit the ground running with the success of the Sonics making the NBA finals in 1978 and



winning the NBA Championship in 1979. While a member of the Sonics, Sikma was named to the NBA All-Star Team for seven straight years from 1979 through 1985. In 1986, Jack continued his basketball career while playing for the Milwaukee Bucks before retiring in 1991.

After retirement from his NBA playing career, Sikma returned to the Seattle area, where he became involved in numerous real estate projects. He also enjoyed being at home with his wife Shawn and raising their three sons together. As part of the Seattle community, Sikma was very involved in supporting the Bellevue Boys and Girls Club, the King County Boys and Girls Club, and hosting a golf tournament supporting Seattle Children's Hospital. Sikma returned to the NBA in 2003, taking a coaching position with the Sonics and remained on the bench as an assistant coach for the next 11 years, including stints in Houston and Minnesota. Since 2014 he continued his involvement as a consultant for NBA teams, including last season for the Toronto Raptors, which culminated with their NBA championship in 2019.

Sikma was recently honored with his induction into the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame as a member of the Class of 2019. It was an extraordinary experience to be able to share the honor during induction weekend in Springfield, MA, with so many of his peers, family, and friends from his hometown of St Anne, IL, his college days at Illinois Wesleyan University, and from the Seattle area. For his next career chapter, Sikma recently joined his wife Shawn at CBBain as a residential real estate broker; and enjoys (so far) working together in the Seattle/Eastside market.



VITO

Vito grew up in New York City among gangs and violence. He did his best to get by but still struggled to escape the scene. Rough crowds, drugs, and self-confidence were all obstacles Vito worked to overcome in his youth. Skipping forward a few years, Vito and his partner found some stability and invested in a new life in Canada. However, he wasn't able to earn his Canadian visa and was sent back over the border without her. Landing in Seattle with nothing but the clothes on his back, Vito found himself homeless, scared, and alone. He needed food and shelter, and he needed to find his way back home.

Vito was referred to Uplift Northwest by a local shelter, and he wasted no time in signing up for work. Vito made such an impression that Uplift Northwest offered him a janitorial position at their own facility and referred him to their STEP 2.0 enhanced job training program. His spirited attitude, positive outlook, and strong work ethic left a lasting impression on all those he encountered at Uplift Northwest. In no time at all, Vito landed two separate security positions, and he was taking back control of his own destiny. Vito credits these work opportunities to the support and guidance of Uplift Northwest's job training program and caring staff. These days, Vito is stably housed and is continuing to work regularly on an Uplift Northwest street cleaning crew.

Throughout his forty year career David Silverman has entertained people as an actor, standup comedian, singer, dancer, choreographer, director and emcee. A familiar face to northwest audiences on stage or on T.V., he has a long list of credits including winning the first Seattle Laugh-off in 1980. 


